Dubai, 30th December 2013: Arabtec Holding PJSC, a leading engineering and construction group specialising in complex projects in the Middle East and North Africa region, announced today that recent market and media speculations regarding increasing its stake in Depa limited by Arabtec are baseless.

Arabtec Holding confirmed that there are no plans at this stage to increase its stake in Depa.

In November 22nd 2012, Arabtec Holding announced the acquisition of 149.55 million shares, 24 per cent stake, in Depa for AED241.670 million (USD65.8 million)
